**Order Following Telephonic  
Conference and Setting  
Hearing Time and Location**

I held a telephonic conference with the parties today to address certain issues arising under the Securities and Exchange Commission's order issued November 30, 2017. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10440, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3724.

Accordingly, the parties may submit, by January 5, 2018, any new evidence they deem relevant to my reexamination of the record. The parties may also submit a brief of no more than 3,000 words explaining the relevance of the new evidence and identifying any challenged rulings, findings, or conclusions. Responsive briefs of no more than 3,000 words may be filed by January 16, 2018. By February 16, 2018, I will issue an order upon reconsideration setting forth whether all prior actions taken by me are ratified or revised in any respect.

In addition, I ORDER that the hearing will commence at 9:30 a.m. Eastern on March 6, 2018, in Washington, D.C., and last one day. If either party wishes to amend its witness or exhibit lists, it should file a motion.
