Order Ratifying Actions

The Securities and Exchange Commission remanded this case to me following the issuance of an initial decision. *See Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10440, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3724 (Nov. 30, 2017). Consistent with the Commission's remand order and my order dated December 14, 2017, Respondents¹ Timothy W. Carnahan and CYIOS Corporation submitted a brief regarding the issues raised in the November 30 order, and the Division of Enforcement submitted a responsive brief. *See Traci J. Anderson, CPA*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5384, 2017 SEC LEXIS 4085 (ALJ Dec. 14, 2017). Respondents also submitted a reply brief that is substantially identical to their opening brief. I have considered the reply even though it was not authorized by my order.

The Division urges me to ratify all prior actions. Respondents urge dismissal of the present proceeding, but otherwise their submissions (which include no new evidence), even construed liberally, address only the proceedings before the Commission pursuant to Respondents' petition for review. In short, no party has identified any actions or decisions of mine for reconsideration or reexamination. I have nonetheless scrutinized the record in accordance with the November 30 order, and I have determined that no

actions of mine or of any other administrative law judge in connection this proceeding need to be revised.²

Therefore, upon reconsideration of the record, I RATIFY all prior actions taken by an administrative law judge in this proceeding. The process contemplated by the Commission's November 30 order is complete.
