**Order for Three Respondents
to Show Cause and Directing
Parties to Hold a Prehearing
Conference**

I previously found that Respondents were served with the order instituting proceedings and that their answers were due by January 29, 2018. *Blacksands Petroleum, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5509, 2018 SEC LEXIS 198 (ALJ Jan. 23, 2018). *Blacksands Petroleum, Inc.*, submitted its answer on January 18, 2018. *China Education Alliance, Inc.*, *DoMark International, Inc.*, and *East Coast Diversified Corp.* did not submit answers.

I ORDER *China Education Alliance, Inc.*, *DoMark International, Inc.*, and *East Coast Diversified Corp.* to SHOW CAUSE by February 16, 2018, why the registration of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If any of the three fails to respond to this order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

I FURTHER ORDER that the parties shall hold an initial prehearing conference without the hearing officer to discuss each numbered item in Rule of Practice 221(c), 17 C.F.R. § 201.221(c).¹ By February 23, 2018, the parties

shall file a joint prehearing conference statement reflecting the results of their conference and proposing a procedural schedule.
