Order Postponing Hearing and Requesting Declaration of Service

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) on February 1, 2018, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for February 20, 2018.

The Division of Enforcement has not yet provided evidence that the remaining Respondents have been served with the OIP.¹ Accordingly, I ORDER the Division to file by February 23, 2018, a declaration concerning the status of service on Respondents.

Further, I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED.
