**Order Finding Service and  
Scheduling Prehearing  
Conference**

On February 20, 2018, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration establishing that the three remaining Respondents (Canwealth Minerals Corp., Cubed, Inc., and Enviro Cleanse, Inc.) were served with the order instituting proceedings (OIP) by February 20 by attempted delivery of the OIP at the most recent address on each Respondent's most recent filing with the Commission. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, Respondents' answers are due by March 5, 2018. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160, .220(b).
