**Motion to Commission  
for Extension of Time  
to File Initial Decision**

I request an extension of the due date for the initial decision from May 21, 2018, to July 20, 2018. The request is made pursuant to Rule 360(a)(3)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, which permits the Chief Administrative Law Judge to request by motion an extension of the time for filing an initial decision. 17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(3)(ii).

The Commission instituted this proceeding on July 14, 2016, pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Sections 203(e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and Section 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. Judge Jason S. Patil held a twenty-four day hearing that produced 6,955 pages of transcript and more than 1,000 exhibits. In addition, the parties have submitted a total of 902 proposed findings of fact, with 1,535 pages written in opposition to those proposed findings.

Judge Patil expects to have his initial decision completed in a few weeks. However, I am requesting a sixty-day extension because an initial decision of this size requires time to review and cite check. The office will only have three law clerks available to support five judges for most of June. A sixty-day extension will ensure that the office has the time it needs to complete the task.
