Order to Show Cause

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding on May 15, 2018, with an order instituting proceedings (OIP) that alleged respondent has securities registered with the Commission and had not filed its required periodic reports. Sonora Resources Corp. was served with the OIP on May 18, 2018. *Sonora Res. Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5764, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1273, at *1 (ALJ May 31, 2018). Its answer was due by May 31, 2018. *See id.*

I held a prehearing conference on June 7, 2018. No one appeared on behalf of Sonora Resources, and it has not filed an answer or contacted the Division of Enforcement.

Accordingly, I ORDER Sonora Resources to SHOW CAUSE by June 18, 2018, why the Commission should not revoke the registration of its registered securities by default for its failure to timely file an answer, participate in the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. *See* OIP at 2-3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
