Notice of Stay

On April 5, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings against Respondent pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Respondent, appearing *pro se*, filed his answer on April 25, 2018. I held a prehearing conference on April 30, 2018, and issued an order on May 7, 2018, setting procedural dates for a motion for summary disposition. *Joshua D. Mosshart*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5716, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1084. On May 21, 2018, the Division filed a motion for summary disposition. Respondent filed his opposition to the motion on June 11, 2018.

This is notice that on June 21, 2018, the Commission stayed effective immediately all matters pending before administrative law judges in light of the Supreme Court's decision in *Lucia v. SEC*, No. 17-130 (U.S. June 21, 2018). *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10510, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1490 (June 21, 2018). The stay will last until July 23, 2018, or further order of the Commission. *Id.*
