Notice of Stay Order

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings on June 20, 2018, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that respondents had securities registered with the Commission and had not filed required periodic reports. A hearing was scheduled to begin on July 16, 2018. *Dev. Capital Grp., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5815, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1492 (ALJ June 21, 2018).

This is notice that after the hearing notice was issued on June 21, 2018, the Commission stayed effective immediately all matters pending before administrative law judges in light of the Supreme Court's decision in *Lucia v. SEC*, No. 17-130 (U.S. June 21, 2018). *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10510, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1490 (June 21, 2018). The hearing is therefore postponed. The stay will last until July 23, 2018, or further order of the Commission. *Id.*
