The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on May 21, 2018. Remaining in the proceeding are Green Parts International, Inc., Integrated Environmental Technologies, Ltd., and Urban Barns Foods, Inc. (Respondents).<sup>1</sup> The OIP provides that each Respondent's Answer is due within ten days of service of the OIP on it. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). Each Respondent was served with the OIP by May 28, 2018, by USPS Express Mail delivery or attempted delivery at "the most recent address shown on [its] most recent filing with the Commission," 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv), and did not file a timely Answer.

On August 22, 2018, in light of *Lucia v. SEC*, 138 S. Ct. 2044 (2018), the Commission ordered a new hearing in each pending proceeding, including this one, before an administrative law judge who had not previously participated in the proceeding, unless the parties expressly agreed to alternative procedures, including agreeing that the proceeding remain with the previous presiding administrative law judge. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at \*2-3. Accordingly, the proceeding was reassigned to the undersigned. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (C.A.L.J. Sept. 12, 2018).

<sup>1</sup> The proceeding has ended as to M2 nGage Group, Inc. (n/k/a Troika Media Group, Inc.) (a/k/a Roomlinx, Inc.), which settled. *Green Parts Int'l, Inc.*, Exchange Act Release No. 83574, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1614 (June 29, 2018).

In view of the reassignment of the proceeding, Respondents were afforded a new opportunity to file Answers, which were due by October 5, 2018. *Green Parts Int'l, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6068, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2573 (Sept. 24, 2018). To date, each Respondent has failed to file an Answer. Accordingly, each Respondent IS ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, by October 17, 2018, why it should not be deemed to be in default and the registration of its securities revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
