Order Regarding Service

On December 30, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Respondent is a defaulted Nevada corporation located in China, and the Division of Enforcement has been attempting to serve it with the OIP under the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters,¹ since January 2016. On October 9, 2018, the Division submitted a declaration in which it stated that Hague service is still pending, and it is attempting to serve the OIP in Nevada.

I ORDER the Division to file an update on the status of its efforts to serve Respondent by January 14, 2019.
