**Second Order Extending  
Deadlines**

The parties submitted a joint motion to extend the due dates for summary disposition briefing. The parties have shown good cause in that the Division of Enforcement needs time to recover from the recent government closure and Mr. Teran is seeking to retain counsel. Accordingly, the motion is GRANTED, and the deadlines are extended as follows:

- March 18, 2019: Motions for summary disposition are due. The Division of Enforcement shall file a motion. Mr. Teran may file a motion at his option.
- April 1, 2019: Oppositions are due. Any Form D-A disclosure and argument supporting an inability to pay defense under Rule 630 is due. 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.630, 209.1.
- April 12, 2019: Replies are due.
