Order on Status

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) on March 21, 2017. The only respondent remaining is China Linen Textile Industry, Ltd., a Cayman Islands corporation located in China, with securities registered with the Commission. The proceeding has been on my docket since September 12, 2018. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (ALJ Sept. 12, 2018).

In response to a notice from the Division of Enforcement that it intended to file for default against China Linen pursuant to Article 15 of the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters,¹ I issued an order suggesting that the Division might consider other methods of achieving service because of concerns about relying on Article 15 of the Hague Convention. *China Biopharma, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6347, 2018 SEC LEXIS 3276, at *2-5 (ALJ Nov. 20, 2018).

I have not heard from the Division since my order. Now that the government shutdown has ended and the stay of administrative proceedings

has been lifted, I would like the Division to let me know how it intends to proceed by February 28, 2019. *See Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10603, 2019 SEC LEXIS 37, at *1 (Jan. 30, 2019).
