The Commission has remanded this proceeding for the purpose of providing Respondents with the opportunity for a new hearing before an administrative law judge who did not previously participate in the matter—unless the parties agreed to alternative procedures by April 17, 2019. *See Harding Advisory LLC*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10617, 2019 SEC LEXIS 555, at *2–3 (Mar. 20, 2019). The parties have not done so.
