The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on December 4, 2017, pursuant to Sections 4C and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.<sup>1</sup> The OIP alleges that Respondents violated the antifraud and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws and engaged in improper professional conduct related to audit and/or interim review engagements for three microcap company clients.

A prehearing conference was held yesterday. All active parties except Michael Deutchman, CPA, appeared. The hearing, previously scheduled to commence on October 8, 2019, was rescheduled to commence on October 15, 2019, in consideration of the religious holiday during the previous week, and will continue in November and possibly December, depending on courtroom availability. The prehearing conference scheduled for September 13, 2019, will be rescheduled to a date to be decided. The prehearing schedule is reset as follows:

September 3, 2019 – Wahl and Chung to exchange and file exhibit lists and provide the Division with pre-marked exhibits.

September 16, 2019 – parties to file any motions in limine, objections to exhibits and witnesses, designations of deposition testimony, prehearing briefs, and stipulations.

September 27, 2019 – parties to file responses to motions in limine, responses to objections, and counter-designations.
