**Order Denying Respondent's  
Motion to Strike**

Respondent Laurie Bebo submitted a motion on October 30, 2019, requesting that I strike the Division of Enforcement's September 27, 2019, supplemental post-hearing brief, and order the Division to comply with previous Securities and Exchange Commission orders prohibiting the reliance on pre-remand orders and decisions. The motion is DENIED. Consistent with the Commission's order remanding pending cases, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058 (Aug. 22, 2018), when I make a decision in this proceeding, I will not consider the pre-remand rulings in this proceeding. I will likewise not consider the language in the Division's brief referring to pre-remand rulings. Any decision I make will be an independent determination based on the developed record and not on rulings preceding the remand. Since I will simply disregard the references to previous rulings, it is unnecessary to strike the Division's brief.
