Order on Respondent's March 16, 2020, Motion

On March 16, 2020, Respondent Mark Feathers submitted a motion requesting a variety of forms of relief.

Respondent asks to modify his subpoena directed toward the Division of Enforcement to include the "work papers" of a Division attorney. This request is denied. The subpoena already encompasses the materials Respondent appears to want to add to it; this modification is unnecessary.

Respondent asks for leave to submit to my office a subpoena directed to the Small Business Administration. This request is granted. By March 25, 2020, Respondent may submit a subpoena drafted with sufficient specificity to permit a reasonable response.

Respondent additionally suggests that I issue a new deadline for subpoenas requiring a person to appear and testify at the hearing. This deadline was postponed pending the resolution of the subpoena and motion to quash. As the Division has not yet submitted its document review proposal, it would be premature to reschedule the deadline at this point.

Respondent also restates his request that I forward information about this proceeding to the Commission's Office of Inspector General. I previously ruled that this request was not ready to be decided, and it remains so. *See Feathers*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6737, 2020 SEC LEXIS 566, at \*2 & n.4 (ALJ Feb. 27, 2020).
