The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on February 7, 2020, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.102(e)(3)(i)(A) and (B) (Rule 102(e)(3)(i)(A) and (B)). The OIP temporarily suspended Randall Goulding, Esq., from appearing or practicing before the Commission as an attorney. On April 21, 2020, pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(iii), the Commission denied Goulding's request that his temporary suspension be lifted and ordered a hearing before an administrative law judge.

A prehearing conference was held today. Donna S. McCaffrey, and Thomas J. Karr, Esqs., appeared for the Office of the General Counsel (OGC), and Eric W. Berry, Esq., appeared for Respondent Goulding. As agreed to by the parties, OGC will file a motion for summary disposition, pursuant to Rule 250. Its motion will be due on May 29, 2020. Goulding's opposition and OGC's reply will be due June 30 and July 21, 2020, respectively.
