**Order on Motion to Correct
the Record Index**

On November 25, 2020, Respondents Gregory A. Wahl, CPA, and Georgia Chung, CPA, moved to correct the record index:

- (1) They note that their February 23, 2018, motion to dismiss is missing from the record index. They are correct. My office will provide the Office of the Secretary with a copy of the motion to include in the record, and I will direct that the record index be revised accordingly.
- (2) They ask that the Securities and Exchange Commission's December 4, 2017, press release accompanying the order instituting proceedings be admitted as an exhibit. I will give the Division of Enforcement until December 2, 2020, to note any objection to its admission.¹ Absent an objection by the Division, I will admit the press release.
- (3) They further note that at least 12 documents are missing from the Commission's public website dedicated to the proceeding. But the Commission's webpage is not the proceeding's official docket, nor does it "necessarily reflect the actual status of the case." U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, Administrative Proceeding Documents,

Rather, the lists “may not be exhaustive” and “are for informational purposes only.” *Id.* Wahl and Chung should instead contact the Office of the Secretary directly with their request to add documents to the website.

- (4) Finally, they state that some attorneys have been unable to find any documents about the proceeding on the online legal research database LexisNexis. The LexisNexis database includes orders issued by administrative law judges and by the Commission in this proceeding. *See, e.g., Anton & Chia, LLP*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6769, 2020 SEC LEXIS 2967 (ALJ June 16, 2020) (most recent ALJ order); Exchange Act Release No. 89475, 2020 SEC LEXIS 2504 (Aug. 4, 2020) (most recent Commission order). This database, however, is only accessible to subscribers. Questions about database access and contents should be directed to LexisNexis.

Once the Division responds by December 2, I will direct the Office of the Secretary to issue a revised record index and exhibit list.
