The Democratic Club of Ojai, California wishes to express its support for the **Petition submitted August 3**. 2011 on Political Spending by Corporations. We urge the commission to develop and enforce rules to require public companies to disclose to shareholders the use of corporate resources for political activities, specifically including donations to so-called "social welfare" groups and trade associations. Included are all Federal and State candidates, PAC's (527's), 501 C 4's or any other such organizations operating to support or opposes candidates or issues of a political nature.

We take this position for two principal reasons:

- 1. Investors have a legitimate interest in receiving information about such spending
- 2. Such information is needed to ensure corporate accountability

More transparency is good in most situations, but full disclosure of corporate donations for political purposes is essential.
