Subject: require disclosure of corporate political donations

Dear SEC Chair:

I request that the SEC require corporations under the SEC's jurisdiction to publicly report their political donations and amounts spent to influence legislation and government policy.

The amounts and recipients should be disclosed on-line and in a timely fashion, for example within a week, and at least some reasonable time before an election.

Efforts to influence legislation and policy should be defined broadly; I have read that there are loopholes to current definitions of "lobbying."
