Dear Chair White,

We write as members of Congress who were leading advocates for the JOBS Act. As you know, the JOBS Act passed both houses of Congress with broad bipartisan support and was signed into law by President Obama on April 5, 2012 (P.L. 112-106).

A key feature of the JOBS Act was Title III, which was supposed to reduce the burdens and hurdles for US startups and entrepreneurs to gain access to critical new sources of capital from more modest investors. The Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) was required by the law to promulgate rules relating to these "crowdfunding" provisions by the end of 2012. The SEC has now missed that deadline by more than 500 days.

There is ample evidence that the market and investors are ready and waiting for the SEC to finalize the rules in a manner that will allow new capital to efficiently find its way to startup companies. Moreover, companies desperate to bring their innovative products to the market are collaborating with businesses that have found avenues around the SEC's delays in promulgating erowdfunding rules. Due in large part to the lack of finalized federal rulemaking, states are now leading the way, harnessing the power of new technologies to connect entrepreneurs with investors. We urge the SEC to comply with Congressional intent to build a new cutting edge infrastructure that will provide innovative funding opportunities for startups and robust investor protections for decades to come.

We are writing to insist that the SEC complete the rulemaking process as quickly as practicable and provide a response indicating a date by which Congress, investors, startups, and other stakeholders can reasonably expect such rules will be promulgated.
