I'm the COO and Co-Founder of an educational technology startup called BrainRush. My co-founder is Nolan Bushnell (original founder of Atari and Chuck E. Cheese).

BrainRush uses short, adaptive learning games to teach foundational knowledge across all subjects and is also a platform for teachers and other users to create their own games. We have over 4000 games and have pilots with 3 of the 5 largest school districts in the country. We've also rolled out our software completely at Central Unified in Fresno, CA, the first one-to-one tablet district in the state of California. We also have major strategic relationships with Teach for America and Dr. Oz's charitable foundation among others.

BrainRush plans to raise money under the proposed Title III rules if they can be expedited to meet our funding goals. We are raising close to \$1M and these proceeds would play a critical role in expanding our team. We currently have 8 full-time employees and would love to double that amount in the next several months. Upon raising funds, BrainRush will be expanding its technical team as well as adding additional employees in marketing, business development and content development.

I would strongly encourage the SEC to pass the JOBS ACT as soon as possible so companies like ours can take advantage of it and hire people immediately.
