The discussion related to (i) the Commission's proposed rule to implement Section 956 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act ("<u>Dodd-Frank</u> <u>Act</u>"), which relates to incentive-based compensation arrangements at covered financial institutions, Release No. 34-64140, File No. S7-12-11; and (ii) Section 953(b) of the Dodd-Frank Act, which requires the Commission to amend Item 402 of Regulation S-K to require disclosure of the ratio of the median annual total compensation of all employees of the issuer to the annual total compensation of the issuer's chief executive officer.
