Dear Chairman Cox:

I am writing to ask that you extend the comment period for the proposed rule published by the Security and Exchange Commission (SEC) on June 25th which would alter the current regulation of certain annuity contracts.

I certainly support efforts to improve the protections afforded to purchasers of annuity products. As Americans decide how to best save for and spend in their retirement, it is incumbent on government at all levels to help people make informed decisions. This task is even more urgent given the continual creation and distribution of new products that add to the options available to individuals but may be less familiar to them.

As financial products become more complicated and combine aspects of more traditional products, how to draft and enforce those protections can become more challenging. Indexed annuities, of course, combine elements of traditional insurance and securities products. As such, I think it is wise to be careful in deciding how to best regulate them. Given the many questions raised about the SEC's proposal, particularly from the state regulators of insurance products, I hope you will extend the comment period beyond September 10th in an effort to find the best way for state and federal regulators to apportion the responsibility for protecting consumers.
