
Dear Secretary:

I respectfully request an opportunity to make an oral presentation in opposition to the above-captioned proposed rules on behalf of the Georgia Republican Party, the New York Republican State Committee and the Tennessee Republican Party (hereinafter, the "State Parties"). The Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC" or "Commission") has published an order to institute proceedings to determine whether to approve or disapprove the proposed rule change. Pursuant to Rule 19b-4, the Commission will consider any request for an opportunity to make an oral presentation.

The Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, Inc. ("FINRA") declined to make changes to the proposed rule text in response to the comments received by the Commission. Only one commenter expressed unconditional support for FINRA's proposal; five commenters raised concerns and recommended amendments; and three commenters, including the State Parties, opposed the proposed rule. I request the opportunity to make an oral presentation on behalf of the State Parties relating to the arguments set forth in the submitted comments.
