**Partial Amendment No. 1 to SR-NASDAQ-2017-055**

On May 26, 2017, The NASDAQ Stock Market LLC (“Nasdaq” or “Exchange”) filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC” or “Commission”) a proposed rule change (“Proposal”) to amend the Rule 7000A series, relating to the Order Audit Trail System; Rule 8211 and Chapter IX, Section IV relating to Electronic Blue Sheets; Chapter VII, Section VII relating to account identification; and Chapter V, Section VII, relating to the Consolidated Options Audit Trail System, to reflect changes to these rules once members are effectively reporting to the Consolidated Audit Trail (“CAT”) adopted pursuant to the National Market System Plan Governing the Consolidated Audit Trail (the “CAT NMS Plan” or “Plan”)<sup>1</sup>, and the CAT’s accuracy and reliability meets certain standards.

The SEC published the Proposal in the Federal Register for notice and comment on June 5, 2017.<sup>2</sup> The comment period expires on June 26, 2017.<sup>3</sup>

The Exchange is filing this Partial Amendment No. 1 to update Section 2, “Procedures of the Self-Regulatory Organization,” of the Proposal. On June 1, 2017, the Exchange obtained the necessary approval from its Board of Directors for this Proposal. Therefore, the Exchange has completed all action required to be taken in connection with this Proposal, as set forth in the general instructions in Form 19b-4, Paragraph “E.” As such, proposed Section 2 would state, “The proposed rule change was approved by the Board of Directors of the Exchange on June 1, 2017. No other action is necessary for the filing of the rule change.”
