Partial Amendment No. 1 to SR-NASDAQ-2017-074

On July 21, 2017, The NASDAQ Stock Market LLC (“Exchange”) filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission a proposed rule change (the “proposal”) to adopt the Midpoint Extended Life Order as a new Order Type available to all members, and by extension their customers, which will reward market participants that commit to a minimum half-second period, during which their order remains unchanged.¹

The Exchange is now filing this Partial Amendment No. 1 to update Item 2, “Procedures of the Self-Regulatory Organization,” in Form 19b-4 of the proposal to reflect the approval of the proposal by the Exchange Board of Directors on July 21, 2017. Consequently, on page 3 of 42 of the Form 19b-4, Item 2, the Exchange proposes to replace the following text,

“The proposed rule change has not yet been approved by the Board of Directors of the Exchange (“Board”). Once it has obtained Board approval, the Exchange plans to file a technical amendment to this proposed rule change to reflect that approval. Once Board approval is obtained, no further action by the Exchange in connection with this proposed rule change will be required.”

with,

“The proposed rule change was approved by the Board of Directors of the Exchange on July 21, 2017. No other action is necessary for the filing of the rule change.”.
