

SR-NYSEArca-2012-66; Amendment No. 2

NYSE Arca, Inc. ("Exchange") hereby amends SR-NYSEArca-2012-66 ("Filing") as follows:

1. The following two sentences are added after the first full sentence on page 21 of the Filing and after the second full sentence of the first full paragraph on page 53 of Exhibit 1 to the Filing:

In particular, for each copper lot held by the Trust, the Trust's website will disclose the warehouse location and warehouse identification number, lot number, net weight of the lot, and brand. The Trust's website will list the copper lots in the order in which they will be delivered in a redemption pursuant to the algorithm referred to above in the section "Redemption of Baskets; Withdrawal of Copper".

The Exchange believes that the proposed rule change, as modified by this amendment, is consistent with the requirement of Section 6(b)(5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934¹ that an exchange have rules that are designed, among other things, to prevent fraudulent and manipulative acts and practices, to promote just and equitable principles of trade, to remove impediments to, and perfect the mechanism of a free and open market and, in general, to protect investors and the public interest. The amendment supplements the representations in the Filing regarding website disclosure and makes clear that the Trust's website will provide detailed information regarding the copper lot holdings of the Trust, including warehouse location and identification numbers, lot number, weight and brand. In addition, the Trust's website will list the copper lots in the order in which they will be delivered in a redemption pursuant to the algorithm as referenced in the Filing. This information will enhance the transparency of the Trust's copper holdings and will provide useful additional information to investors regarding an investment in the Trust's Shares.

All other representations in the Filing remain as stated therein and no other changes are being made.
