## SR-NYSEArca-2020-94; Partial Amendment No. 2

NYSE Arca, Inc. ("NYSE Arca" or the "Exchange") hereby submits this partial amendment to SR-NYSEArca-2020-94 filed on October 20, 2020. On December 9, 2020, the Exchange filed Amendment No. 1 to the original filing. The purpose of this partial amendment is to correct a representation made in Amendment No. 1. Specifically, the Exchange proposes to replace the last sentence of the first full paragraph under *Trading Rules* on page 13 of Amendment No. 1, and on page 36 of the Notice of Proposed Rule Change (Exhibit 1), with the following: "A minimum of 100,000 Shares of each Fund will be outstanding at the commencement of trading on the Exchange."
