**AND NOW, this 12 day of JAN, 2015, upon consideration of the**

**request of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") for an extension of time in which to submit a final distribution plan (the "Distribution Plan") to the Court and for an Order To Show Cause regarding the proposed distribution described in Docket Nos. 324, 329, 331, and 333 (the "Proposed Distribution"):**

**I.**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, pursuant to this Court's Order dated January 8, 2015, Docket No. 333, the Commission shall submit the Distribution Plan to the Court no later than February 27, 2015, unless for good cause shown; and

**II.**

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that within five (5) business days of the entry of this Order to Show Cause, the Commission shall serve on all identified Investors, and all proposed recipients of payments under the Proposed Distribution, at their last known address, a letter

describing the process for submitting objections described herein, a description of their respective claim as currently understood by the Commission, and identifying the Commission's public website dedicated to the captioned matter, set forth below in paragraph III, at which they can obtain a copy of this Order and other filings referenced herein. Service under this paragraph may be made by first-class mail.

### III.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Commission shall post this Order and copies of the docket entries 324, 329, 331, and 333 on the Commission's website for the captioned matter, located at:

<http://www.sec.gov/divisions/enforce/claims/robertstinson.htm>

to alert Investors and other interested parties of whom the Commission is now unaware or cannot locate, and this website posting shall be sufficient notice of the proposed distribution to all such unknown or unlocated Investors and interested parties.

### IV.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, no later than January 31, 2015, Investors and any other interested entities shall show cause, if there is any, why this Court should not enter an Order approving a distribution plan for the Proposed Distribution, as modified to reflect interest accretions and other adjustments based on additional information submitted to the Commission, including objections as described herein. This shall be done by correspondence sent to counsel for the Commission at the address set forth below, stating all objections to the Proposed Distribution. All such correspondence must be sent by January 31, 2015.

To the extent that an objection is based on a claimed right to a distribution not described in the Proposed Distribution, or a claimed mistake in the loss calculation, the objection must

demonstrate, under penalty of perjury, the grounds for such claim, and be accompanied by documentation sufficient to prove the claimed inaccuracy or omission. This can be done by setting forth in detail the basis for the objection and including at the end of the statement the phrase: "I declare pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing is true and correct," and signing and dating the document. All letters submitted pursuant to this paragraph must be sent by January 31, 2015, include current contact information for the submitting entity, and must be sent either by receipted mail, or receipted electronic mail to:

**V.**

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, if no objections to the Proposed Distribution are submitted as directed within the allotted time period, the Commission shall:

- file a notice so advising the Court, accompanied by a copy of the Distribution Plan, modified to reflect interest accretions and other adjustments based on additional information submitted to the Commission, as well as a proposed Order approving that plan; and
- Post a copy of the notice, the Distribution Plan, and proposed Order on the website identified in paragraph III., above.

Upon receipt of the notice and Distribution Plan from the Commission, the Court may enter the proposed Order without further notice or passage of time.

#### VI.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, if the Commission receives any objections to the Proposed Distribution, the Commission shall:

- file a memorandum so advising the Court, accompanied by a copy of the Distribution Plan, modified to reflect interest accretions and other adjustments based on additional information submitted to the Commission, including objections as described herein, and describing the Objections as well as its resolution of the same,
- file a proposed Order approving the Distribution Plan;
- serve of copy of the memorandum, Distribution Plan, and proposed Order on all Objecting Parties with whom the Commission has not been able to reach consensual resolution; and
- Post a copy of the memorandum, Distribution Plan, and proposed Order on the website identified in paragraph III., above;

Upon receipt of the memorandum and Distribution Plan from the Commission, the Court may enter the proposed Order without further notice or passage of time.

#### VII.

Except as otherwise specifically stated above, the publication of any filings described above, including the Distribution Plan, on the website identified in paragraph III., above, shall constitute, and suffice as, notice of the Distribution Plan. No further comment period will be provided unless expressly ordered by the Court.

**VIII.**

If the Court deems it necessary or appropriate, the Court may conduct a hearing before approving the Distribution Plan. Notice of a hearing shall be provided through the Court Docket and on the website identified in paragraph III., above.
