(2) DIRECT PAYMENT OF TAXES, TAX ADMINISTRATOR, AND INVESTOR NO. 4,
AND (3) DISCHARGE FUND AND TAX ADMINISTRATORS**

The Court, having reviewed Plaintiff's motion and supporting declaration, and for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Plaintiff's motion is GRANTED.
2. The Clerk of Court is directed to disburse to the Commission all amounts remaining in the Court's registry account for this matter, less any fees due to the Court. Payment to the Commission may be made as follows:
 - a. Electronically, wherein the Commission will provide detailed ACH transfer/Fedwire instructions upon request;
 - b. Direct payment from a bank account via Pay.gov through the Commission's website at <http://www.sec.gov/about/offices/ofm.htm>; or
 - c. By certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order,

made payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission and setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Order. The funds may be hand-delivered or mailed to:

3. Upon receipt, the Commission shall:
 - a. Issue payment to Investor No. 4 by check with a one-year stale date;
 - b. Pay any taxes due on behalf of the distribution fund;
 - c. Pay the Tax Administrator's final fees and expenses; and thereafter
 - d. Remit any remaining funds to the U.S. Treasury.
4. Upon completion of these tasks the Fund and Tax Administrators will be deemed discharged without further order from the Court.
