## ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR ORDER AUTHORIZING DISTRIBUTION AGENTS TO ENGAGE A THIRD-PARTY ADMINISTRATOR AND PAY THE THIRD-PARTY ADMINISTRATOR'S FEE

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court on Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's (the "Commission") Motion for Order Authorizing Distribution Agents to Engage a Third-Party Administrator and Pay the Third-Party Administrator's Fee (the "Motion") [ECF No. 238]. Having reviewed the Motion and the record and being otherwise fully advised, the Court finds good cause to grant the Commission's request. Based thereon, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Motion is GRANTED. It is further ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- 1. The Distribution Agents are authorized to retain Epiq Class Actions & Claims Solutions, Inc. ("Epiq") as the Third-Party Administrator for the Fair Fund in this case at the set fee of \$19,250; and
- 2. The Distribution Agents are authorized to pay Epiq's fee of \$19,250 from the Fair Fund without further Order of this Court. The Distribution Agents shall not pay Epiq any fees above \$19,250 without further Order of this Court. The Distribution Agents shall provide an accounting of the fees paid to Epiq in the final accounting

of the Fair Fund once any Court-authorized distribution is completed.
