Pursuant to Rule 411 of the Rules of Practice, 1/ the petitions of the Division of Investment Management and American Electric Power Company, Inc. for review of the administrative law judge's initial decision and the cross-petition of the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association and the American Public Power Association for review of that decision 2/ are granted.

ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice, 5/ that briefs in support of the petitions for review shall be filed by July 7, 2005. Briefs in opposition shall be


