BRIEFS

Pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice 411,<sup>1</sup> the petition of BioElectronics Corp., IBEX, LLC, St. John's, LLC, Andrew J. Whelan, and Kelly A. Whelan, CPA, for review of the administrative law judge's initial decision<sup>2</sup> is granted. Pursuant to Rule of Practice 411(d),<sup>3</sup> the Commission will determine what sanctions, if any, are appropriate in this matter.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule of Practice 450(a),<sup>4</sup> that a brief in support of the petition for review shall be filed by March 30, 2017. A brief in opposition shall

be filed by May 1, 2017, and any reply brief shall be filed by May 15, 2017.<sup>5</sup> Pursuant to Rule of Practice 180(c),<sup>6</sup> failure to file a brief in support of the petition may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.
