ORDER DENYING
WITHDRAWAL OF
REGISTRATION STATEMENT
UNDER THE SECURITIES ACT
OF 1933

1. EDGARizing Solutions, Inc. (“EDGARizing Solutions”) filed a Form S-1 registration statement with the Commission on August 20, 2013 (the “Registration Statement”). The Registration Statement is still pending. The Registration Statement was filed with respect to a primary offering of two million shares of common stock of EDGARizing Solutions.

2. On May 5, 2014, EDGARizing Solutions filed an application to withdraw the Registration Statement pursuant to Rule 477 of Regulation C of the Commission’s General Rules and Regulations under the Securities Act of 1933 (“Securities Act”), 17 C.F.R. § 230.477.

3. On November 7, 2013, the Commission issued an order pursuant to Section 8(e) of the Securities Act authorizing the making of an examination to determine whether a stop order should be issued against the Registration Statement pursuant to Section 8(d) of the Securities Act.

4. After considering EDGARizing Solutions’ application and the ongoing examination, the Commission has determined that the granting of the withdrawal request is not consistent with the public interest and the protection of investors. Accordingly, it is hereby:

ORDERED that EDGARizing Solutions’ application to withdraw its registration statement on Form S-1 filed August 20, 2013, is denied in accordance with Rule 477.
