GRANTING
PETITION
FOR REVIEW
AND SCHEDULING
BRIEFS

Pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice 411,¹ the petition of Accredited Business Consolidators Corp. for review of the administrative law judge's initial decision is granted.² In addressing the issues raised by the petition, the parties are also directed to address whether the initial decision should be summarily affirmed pursuant to Rule of Practice 411(e).³ Pursuant to Rule of Practice 411(d),⁴ the Commission will determine what sanctions, if any, are appropriate in this matter.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule of Practice 450(a),⁵ that a brief in support of the petition for review shall be filed by February 13, 2015. A brief in opposition shall be filed by March 16, 2015, and any reply brief shall be filed by March 30, 2015.⁶ Pursuant to Rule of
