BRIEFS

Wanda L. Gilmer filed an application, pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934,<sup>1</sup> for review of action taken against her by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (“FINRA”). FINRA filed a copy of the index to the record on February 1, 2017, pursuant to Rule 420(d) of the Rules of Practice.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,<sup>3</sup> that a brief in support of the application for review shall be filed by March 31, 2017. A brief in

opposition shall be filed by May 1, 2017, and any reply brief shall be filed by May 15, 2017.<sup>4</sup> Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice,<sup>5</sup> failure to file a brief in support of the application may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.

In their briefs, the parties should address, in addition to any other issues on appeal, whether Gilmer's appeal should be dismissed as untimely pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice 420(b).<sup>6</sup>
