BRIEFS

Edward Beyn and Craig S. Taddonio filed applications, pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934,¹ for review of disciplinary actions taken against them by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority ("FINRA"). FINRA filed a copy of the index to the record on March 13, 2019, pursuant to Rule 420(e) of the Rules of Practice.²

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,³ that briefs in support of the applications for review shall be filed by May 2, 2019. Briefs in

opposition shall be filed by June 3, 2019, and any reply briefs shall be filed by June 17, 2019.⁴ Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice, failure to file a brief in support of the application may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.⁵
