SCHEDULING
BRIEFS

ABN AMRO Clearing Chicago, LLC, filed an application, pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934,¹ for review of disciplinary action taken against it by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated ("CBOE"). CBOE filed a copy of the index to the record on May 16, 2019, pursuant to Rule 420(e) of the Rules of Practice.²

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,³ that a brief in support of the applications for review shall be filed by July 5, 2019. A brief in

opposition shall be filed by August 5, 2019, and any reply brief shall be filed by August 19, 2019.⁴ Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice, failure to file a brief in support of the application may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.⁵
