ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

On September 24, 2019, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings (“OIP”) against Roman Sledziejowski pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹ It appears that there have been no other filings in this proceeding since issuance of the OIP, including as to whether the OIP was served upon Sledziejowski. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by January 17, 2020, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
