KJM Securities, Inc., filed an application, pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934,¹ for review of disciplinary action taken against it by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (“FINRA”). FINRA filed a copy of the index to the record on December 18, 2019, pursuant to Rule 420(e) of the Rules of Practice.²

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,³ that a brief in support of the application for review shall be filed by February 27, 2020. A brief in

opposition shall be filed by March 30, 2020, and any reply brief shall be filed by April 13, 2020.⁴ Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice, failure to file a brief in support of the application may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.⁵
