The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) on July 26, 2013, alleging that Duoyuan Printing, Inc. (Duoyuan Printing), has securities registered with the Commission and has been delinquent in its periodic filings for over two years and thus has failed to comply with Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Exchange Act Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13. As of this date, there is nothing in the record that shows Duoyuan Printing has been served with the OIP. I expect service to be accomplished before a prehearing conference is held.

It appears that I might be presiding at a hearing out of town on February 14, 2014, the date set for a telephonic prehearing conference. For this reason, I POSTPONE the prehearing conference to March 19, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. If the Division of Enforcement accomplishes service on Duoyuan Printing before this date, it should inform my Office.
