PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings on May 5, 2014, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934, against GeNOsys, Inc. (GeNOsys).

A telephonic prehearing conference was held today, attended by Daniel Wadley and Alison Okinaka for the Division of Enforcement, and Joshua Little and John Berger on behalf of GeNOsys. Service was determined to have occurred on May 12, 2014, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).

The parties agreed to the following briefing schedule for motions for summary disposition:

July 18, 2014: Motions for summary disposition are due;

August 1, 2014: Oppositions are due; and

August 11, 2014: Replies, if any, are due.
