ORDER DESIGNATING
PRESIDING JUDGE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) has ordered, pursuant to Rule 100(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, that a public hearing shall be convened at a time and place to be fixed by, and before, the Administrative Law Judge assigned to the proceedings instituted against Natural Blue Resources, Inc., James E. Cohen, and Joseph A. Corazzi on July 16, 2014, (the "Natural Blue Proceedings") and that the Administrative Law Judge shall issue an initial decision no later than 120 days from the date of an initial decision in the Natural Blue Proceedings, or from the date of any order of the Commission accepting an offer of settlement in the Natural Blue Proceedings. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.100(c).
