ORDER FINDING THAT
RESPONDENT CONQUEST
PETROLEUM INC. HAS
SATISFIED ORDER TO SHOW
CAUSE AND RESCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On August 6, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Conquest Petroleum Inc. (Conquest) and Nexaira Wireless Inc. (Nexaira) (collectively, Respondents), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. On August 28, 2014, Respondents were ordered to show cause by September 12, 2014, why this proceeding should not be determined against them for failure to file Answers to the OIP, which were due by August 26, 2014. *Conquest Petroleum*, Admin Proc. Rulings Release No. 1732, 2014 SEC LEXIS 3078 (Order to Show Cause).

This Office received an undated letter from Conquest on September 3, 2014, which says it is in response to the OIP and the August 6, 2014, Order Scheduling Hearing and Designating Presiding Judge, both of which Conquest says it received on August 21, 2014. There is no indication in the letter that Conquest has received other orders from this Office and Conquest notes that it has a new address, different from that where service was attempted. Therefore, I find good cause for Conquest's delay in participating in this proceeding, construe Conquest's letter as its Answer, and find Conquest has satisfied the Order to Show Cause.¹

It is ORDERED that the telephonic prehearing conference scheduled for October 3, 2014, is RESCHEDULED and will be held sooner, on September 16, 2014, at 11:30 a.m. EDT.
