ORDER POSTPONING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On August 6, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A prehearing conference is currently scheduled for October 2, 2014.

On September 29, 2014, this office received the Division of Enforcement's Status Report and Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference. The Division's filing reports that the OIP was sent to Respondent at the address listed in its most recent filing with the Commission, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). The Division represents that a former officer of the Respondent who lives at that address received the OIP, and the Division is currently attempting to procure a declaration from him acknowledging service. A tracking number for the OIP has not yet registered as delivered on www.usps.com, which would provide alternative proof of service.¹ To allow time to obtain proof of service and any answer by Respondent, the October 2, 2014, prehearing conference is POSTPONED to Monday, October 27, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. EDT.
