ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND
SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On November 13, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondents, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The OIP alleges that Respondents each have a class of securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for December 1, 2014.

On November 18, 2014, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by November 18, 2014. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). Thus, Respondents' Answers are due by Monday, December 1, 2014. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

It is ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for December 1, 2014, is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a prehearing conference by telephone will be held on January 5, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. EST, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then. Any Respondent that fails to file an Answer within the time provided will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
