ORDER FOLLOWING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On October 27, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent Thrastos Tommy Petrou, pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940.

A telephonic prehearing conference was held today, attended by the Division of Enforcement and Respondent's counsel. At the prehearing conference, service of the OIP on Respondent was deemed to have occurred on November 1, 2014.

The parties agreed to the following briefing schedule for motions for summary disposition:

February 6, 2015: Motions for summary disposition are due;

March 6, 2015: Oppositions are due;

March 16, 2015: Replies, if any, are due.

The parties also agreed that if a hearing is scheduled in this matter, it will be held in New York City, New York.
