ORDER POSTPONING HEARING  
AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE

On November 26, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The OIP alleges that Respondents each have a class of securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is currently scheduled for December 10, 2014.

On December 3, 2014, the Division of Enforcement (Division) filed the Declaration of Neil J. Welch, Jr. to Assist Secretary with Record of Service, which represents that Respondents Biocol, Inc. (Biocol), Biomass Processing Technology, Inc. (Biomass), Biomedtex, Inc. (Biomedtex), and Carnegie International Corp. (Carnegie), were served with the OIP by November 28, 2014. The Division has not yet provided proof of service for Respondent Bingo.com, Inc., and it is unclear whether Biocol was properly served, as the Division's declaration shows service on what appears to be an incorrect address. I find that Respondents Biomass, Biomedtex, and Carnegie were served on November 28, 2014, and therefore their Answers are due by Thursday, December 11, 2014. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §201.160(b), .220(b).

Accordingly, I ORDER that the hearing scheduled for December 10, 2014, is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on Tuesday, January 6, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. EST.
